Our Estate Vineyard



This cool climate vineyard allows the grapes to develop rich and complex flavors over an exceptionally long growing season. These distinct and age—worthy wines from Regan Vineyards reflect this unique location. We are committed to sustainable winegrowing practices such as: cover crops, biodiesel, solar electricity and biological pest control.

Winemaker's Notes

A blend of three Northern Italian varietals, the 2020 La Vita has Dolcetto leading the way, followed Nebbiolo and Refosco. Primary scents of cardamom, cinnamon, tobacco, and potpourri fill the nose. As the wine opens secondary scents of cranberry, currant, and red fruits begin to appear. On the palate the wine has a bright acidity, creamy midpalate, and a lasting savory finish. The extended barrel aging of 30 months allows the wine to integrate and soften the overall mouthfeel. Enjoy now, or cellar for up to 5-10 more years if you prefer.

Suggested food pairings include creamy cheeses, rich Italian dishes, tri-tip, and meatballs.
